LODGE AND HOMESTEAD INFORMATION

An ideal, inexpensive holiday park close to Christchurch City suitable for School camps, Youth groups, Sports groups and Clubs.

36 Bed Lodge:

Situated away from the main accommodation, surrounded by large open grass areas and shelter trees.

The lodge has one large hall with 6 bunkrooms off this each sleeping 6 people with plenty of showers and toilets. A wood burner provides warmth and for extra heating there are wall heaters that are operated by \$2.00 coins.

Catering: Self cater in our well equipped kitchen or catering can be arranged

Linen/bedding: Hire @ \$7.50 per bed (one off cost) or bring your own.

Cost: Adults/Children \$17.00 per person/night. Minimum nightly rate of \$250.00 applies. Payment on arrival unless prior arrangement has been made.

Deposit: \$50.00 or 10% (whichever is the greater) to confirm.

18 Bed Homestead:

Close to the lodge this self contained homestead is great for smaller groups or to take the overflow from the lodge.

The homestead has three large bedrooms & one sunroom plus a large comfortable kitchen/family area. Two showers & toilets plus a full equipped wheelchair bathroom. A wood burner in the family area heats the whole house.

Catering: Self cater only in a well equipped kitchen.

Line /bedding: Hire @ \$7.50 per bed (one off cost) or bring your own.

Costs: Adults/Children \$21.00 per person/night. Minimum nightly rate of \$170.00 applies. Payment on arrival unless prior arrangement has been made.

Deposit: \$50.00 or 10% (whichever is the greater) to confirm.

Other Accommodation Includes:

- 16 self contained tourist flats
- 10 standard cabins
- 4 kitchen cabins
- Power & tent sites

Security & Arrival Details

Security:

Barrier arms operate 24 hours. Swipe cards will be issued for those vehicles staying and a \$20.00 bond is required for each card. Please ensure that parents, campers etc understand that if they arrive outside your pre-arranged arrival time then they will need to stop at the office to gain access.

After office hours you will need to meet your people at the barrier arm and swipe them through.

Visitors:

It is your responsibility to ensure that your visitors understand that outside office hours there is no vehicle access to the park so they will need to park up and walk. We reserve the right to charge a \$2.00 visitor entry fee per vehicle. Contact the office regarding this.

Cell phones: 021 cell phones have limited coverage at the park, please ensure you have an 027 or 022 phone if you wish people to contact you.

Health & Safety Warden:

Ensure a person has been appointed to this position and they familiarize themselves with the emergency procedure. A list of all those staying and the warden's name must be handed into the office on arrival before keys will be issued.

In the event of a fire or emergency please exit the main entrance or the nearest exit door.

Make contact with the office **or** outside office hours use the emergency phone on the outside of the office door **or** Dial 111 from your cell phone.

Assemble in the grass area outside B Block.

We will go over the procedure with you on arrival and all keys must be signed in and signed out by the Health & Safety Warden.

The attached guest list must be filled out and handed in on arrival.

Arrival/Departure:

Arrival 1pm. Departure strictly 10am, however a midday departure can be arranged depending on forward bookings. If you are wanting a later departure contact the office for further details. A \$70.00 surcharge applies for all departures after 12:00 midday.

Cleaning prior to departure:

- Please remove all rubbish from bunk-rooms and hall.
- Vacuum bunkrooms.
- Sweep main hall, kitchen & inside toilets.
- Leave kitchen clean & tidy.
- Stack chairs & tables away neatly in the storeroom - keep stacker chairs with handles together, separate from those without.
- Strip sheets and pillow cases off the bunks and leave in a pile in the hall.
- Please check you haven't accidentally taken any of our equipment home.
- Ensure all heaters and lights are turned off.
- Ensure all buildings are LOCKED on departure.

Activities within walking distance.

- The popular Bottle Lake Plantation is on our boundary with plenty of walks and mountain biking on well marked & maintained tracks. Bike hire can be arranged.
- The beach is only 500m away and is patrolled in summer.
- A small animal & bird park is free for all to enjoy.
- The Christchurch City Council's Learning Through Action team run environmental education programmes for students at the beach, Brooklands lagoon and in the pine forest. Check out their website for more information: www.ccc.govt.nz/LearningThroughAction
- Brooklands Lagoon has bird watching and many walks through the wetlands.
- Spencer Park has a new state of the art adventure playground which includes mini golf, tennis court, sand volley ball, toddler's pool, wheel chair swing plus much more.
